

RESOLUTION NO. 476

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF KALAMA, COWLITZ COUNTY, WASHINGTON, SETTING FEES FOR BUILDING PERMITS AND RELATED MATTERS

WHEREAS the City of Kalama has adopted a new Building Code; and

WHEREAS the City of Kalama reviews annually and sets fees for services by resolution of the City Council;

NOW THEREFORE be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Kalama:

SECTION 1: Building Permit Fees. Fees for building permits are due at the time of permit issuance and shall be calculated according to the table below:

\$501 to \$2,000	\$25.50 for the first \$500 plus \$3.20 for each additional \$100
\$2,001 to \$25,000	\$73.50 for the first \$2,000 plus \$14.60 for each additional \$1,000
\$25,001 to \$50,000	\$409.30 for the first \$25,000 plus \$10.50 for each additional \$1,000
\$50,001 to \$100,000	\$671.80 for the first \$50,000 plus \$7.30 for each additional \$1,000
\$100,001 to \$500,000	\$1036.80 for the first \$100,000 plus \$5.85 for each additional \$1,000
\$500,001 to \$1,000,000	\$3,376.80 for the first \$500,000 plus \$5.00 for each additional \$1,000
\$1,000,001 and up	\$5,876.80 for the first \$1,000,000 plus \$3.80 for each additional \$1,000

SECTION 2: Plan Review Fee. The fee for reviewing plans for building permits is 65 percent of the building permit fee paid at the time of plan submittal. If an applicant submits all at the same time, plans for identical buildings for one or two family dwellings under the International Residential Code, the plan review fee shall be **\$35.00** per plan after the first one. These fees are in addition to the permit fees in Section 1.

SECTION 3: Plumbing Permit Fees. The fees for plumbing and gas piping permits include both a permit issuance fee and a unit fee. The fees are calculated according to the table below:

SECTION 4: Mechanical Fee. The fees for mechanical and gas piping permits include both a permit issuance fee and a unit fee. The fees are calculated according to the table below:

<p>For the installation or relocation of each boiler or compressor over 15 horsepower (52.7 kW) to and including 30 horsepower (105.5 kW), or each absorption system over 500,000 Btu/h (146.6 kW) to and including 1,000,000 Btu/h (293.1 kW)</p>	\$35.00
<p>For the installation or relocation of each boiler or compressor over 30 horsepower (105.5 kW) to and including 50 horsepower (176 kW), or each absorption system over 1,000,000 Btu/h (293.1 kW) to and including 1,750,000 Btu/h (512.9 kW)</p>	\$50.00

Section 5: Excavation and Grading plan review fees. The fees are calculated according to the table below:

10,001 to 100,000 cubic yards	\$49.25 for the first 10,000 cubic yards plus \$24.50 for each additional 10,000 cubic yards or fraction thereof.
100,001 to 200,000 cubic yards	\$269.75 for the first 100,000 cubic yards plus \$13.25 for each additional 10,000 cubic yards or fraction thereof.
200,001 cubic yards or more	\$402.25 for the first 200,000 cubic yards plus \$7.25 for each additional 10,000 cubic yards or fraction thereof.

Section 6. Excavation and Grading Permit Fees. The fees are calculated according to the table below:

Value	Permit Fee
50 cubic yards or less	\$23.50
51 to 100 cubic yards	\$37.00
101 to 1000 cubic yards	\$37.00 for the first 100 cubic yards plus \$17.50 for each additional 100 cubic yards or fraction thereof.
1001 to 10,000 cubic yards	\$194.50 for the first 1000 cubic yards plus \$14.50 for each additional 1000 cubic yards or fraction thereof.
10,001 to 100,000 cubic yards	\$325.00 for the first 10,000 cubic yards plus \$66.00 for each additional 10,000 cubic yards or fraction thereof.
100,001 cubic yards or more	\$919.00 for the first 100,000 cubic yards plus \$36.50 for each additional 10,000 cubic yards or fraction thereof.

Section 7. Other Fees. Fees for other services are as follows:
